Below are three ideas to kickstart your brainstorming and planning process:

- 1. Host a "Thanks a Latte" Coffee and Donut celebration for participating educators
- 2. Have a potluck meeting and invite both educators and families to engage in a bit of reflection/debrief of the week
- 3. Organize a PTHV mini-conference

Some partnering districts, including Washoe County School District in Reno, Nevada, have embraced mini-conferences as a way to extend their practice. These half-day professional learning opportunities typically kick off with a ceremonial start with key messages by supportive superintendents and school board members as well as educator awards, which is then followed by a general assembly and breakout sessions.
